- 3. If my ailment or condition should worsen or if a new ailment should appear, I should consult my physician or any other licensed physician.
- 4. I have not been guaranteed any success concerning the uses and affects of acupuncture or Chinese herbal medicine. I understand that I am free to discontinue treatment at any time.
- 5. Confidentiality will be preserved at all times. I have received, read and understand the *Notice of Privacy Practices* and *Practices Regarding Disclosure of Client Health Information*.
- 6. I understand that my appointment time is a time set aside for me. If I cancel, miss, or change the appointment without at least 24 hours' notice I understand I will be charged a \$50 fee (or \$100 for an initial visit) for this time. I understand my practitioner's ability to best serve other clients and me is dependent upon my cooperation with this cancellation policy.
- 7. I understand that my practitioner will do what he or she can to accommodate me if I am running late. However, if I arrive too late to be seen, I understand I will be charged a \$50 fee.
